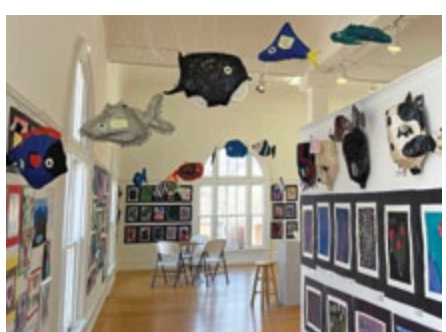
#### March is Reading Month

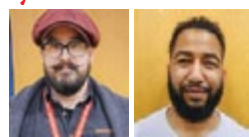

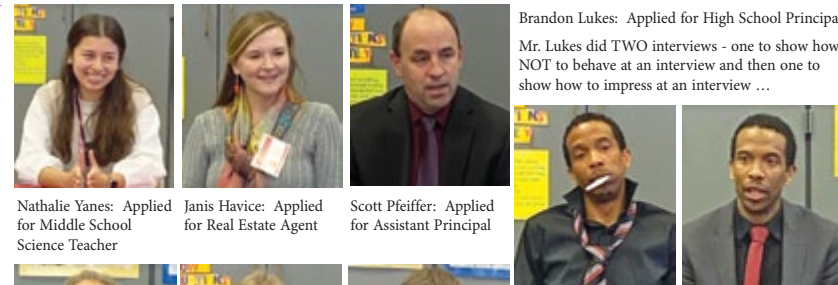
#### March is Reading Month

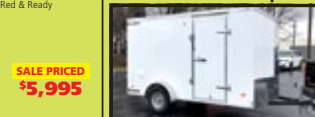

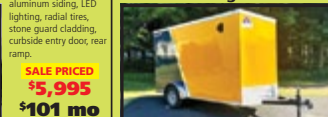
