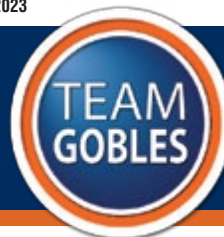

On Thursday, April 13, Gobles High School Band sent four students to Western Michigan University's 53rd Annual Spring Conference and All Star Band! These students were nominated by Mrs. Redmond and had to audition to be accepted to the All Star Band, which consists of 120 high school band members from throughout the state of Michigan. Colton Colingsworth (freshman), Mina Buchkowski (senior), Emma Nuyen (junior), and Dante Clemence (sophomore) spent the day working with music professionals, attending workshops, and watching concerts by high school and university bands. They even watched a concert by WMU's Advanced Jazz Ensemble, which includes class of 2020 Gobles graduates Joe Miller and Owen Cramer! They concluded their day by playing in the annual All Star Band concert. They had a great day and we are very proud of them!

Reading & Donuts

At the start of the new semester, Success classes were changed-up to tackle some of the gaps in students' learning or behavior. Based upon test scores and teacher input, students were divided up into one of four new Success classes: Tiger Way (work on strengthening successful classroom behaviors), math intervention (build up math skills), English intervention (strengthen English and reading skills), and independent study (complete homework, as usual).

One part of Mrs. Harbaugh's and Mr. Merrell's English intervention class was to set a nine-week reading goal to try to read 12,000 pages before the end of the marking period. The two teachers and the students started every day with 10 minutes of silent reading from a self-selected book. When students finished a book, they reported the number of pages in the book to Mrs. Harbaugh, who added up the pages at the end of every week to see how close the reading team was to achieving their goal. They achieved their goal and surpassed their goal by 2,972 pages on the last day of the marking period. That means the class read 14,972 pages in nine weeks!

Mrs. Harbaugh said, "I am so proud of these kids. They looked like deer in headlights when we told them we were going to try to read 12,000 pages by the end of the marking period. Then, we added that donuts just might be the reward if we worked hard and reached our goal. Today (March 24) was the day that we were able to celebrate our accomplishment as a class! Almost 15,000 pages! They did a great job celebrating each book read." Mr. Eichler even came down and awarded each student a coupon for a free Concrete Mixer from Culver's.

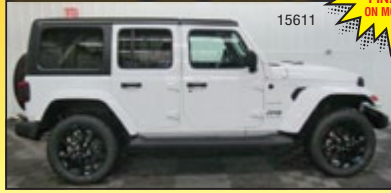

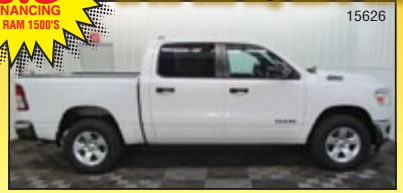
