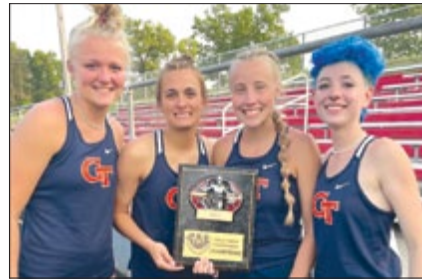

Tiger Varsity Girls win All-Conference honors

From Coach Andrew Wood: June 1, 2023

The girls Varsity Track team had a busy schedule last week. On Tuesday May 23rd, we traveled to Constantine for the SAC meet and came home as conference champions. Earning All-Conference honors were Morgan Modert in the 100, Alyson Tripp honorable mention in the 200, Madison Cooley honorable mention in the 400 and 1600, Kaya Huizenga in the High Jump, Sasha Doll honorable mention in the High Jump. We also won all three sprint relays to earn all conference awards there also. The 4x100 team of Deanna Wood, Modert, Liz Woodard, Huizenga won in a school record time of 51.88. The 4x200 team of D. Wood, Modert, Tripp, Huizenga won in a school record time of 1:50.57. The 4x400 team of D. Wood, Zoie Wood, Modert, and Cooley won with a time of 4:26.95. The 4x800 relay team of Z. Wood, D. Wood, Halle Bigelow, and Cooley earned honorable mention by placing 4th. Great work ladies.

On Saturday May 27th we traveled to Mount Pleasant to compete for the MITCA team state Championship. They competed hard and finished 4th in the State. Top performances came from Kaya Huizenga and Sasha Doll who finished 1st and 2nd in the High jump, Madison Cooley who finished 1st in the 400 and 4th in the 800. The 4x100 team of Doll, Deanna Wood, Liz Woodard,

and Morgan Modert, and 4x200 team of D. Wood, Woodard, Aly Tripp, Huizenga won in dominating fashion by finishing 1 to 2 seconds ahead of 2nd place. The 4x400 team of D. Wood, Zoie Wood, Modert, and Cooley were 3rd. Modert, Huizenga, and Woodard finished 2nd, 3rd, and 7th in the 100. In the 200 we took 3rd and 5th with Tripp and Modert. Woodard also finished in 4th for the long jump. The 4x800 team of Halle Bigelow, Z. Wood, Samantha Paladi, and Cooley finished in 6th. Make sure to congratulate the entire team for their overall effort on Saturday, some of them ran events they have never done before just to earn the team some more points, Sarah Weida in the 1600 and Taleigh Sylvester in the 3200. Also scoring points for the team were: Olivia Sweet in both 100 and 300 hurdles, Shot Put and Discus, Claire Bodin in the Shot Put and Discus, Ellie Wood in the Long Jump and 400, Halle Bigelow in the 800, Sam Paladi in the 1600 and Discus, Charlotte Zantello in the Long Jump and 3200, Kaylee Germain in the Shot Put. Zoie Wood Cleared opening height in the Pole Vault for the 3rd meet in a row to earn 14 team points. The team "Tough as Nails" award goes out to Litzzy Ostiguin for running the 1600 AND 3200 on this HOT late May day and earning her team 17 points to secure our 4th place finish.
