Saturday to compete in the D-4 Track and Field State Championships. Overall they came home with more medals than any time in the previous 10 years and finished 9th overall.

The Lady Tigers traveled to Hudsonville this past 51.39 and also earning All-State Honors. Madison Cooley ran in the 400 meter dash and finished in 8th place to earn a medal and All-State Honors as a freshman with a time of 1:01.87. Aly Tripp then competed in the 300 hurdles, even though she wasn't feeling 100% and finished in 29th place. It was a quick turnaround for Madison Cooley as she then competed in the 800 meter run and finished in 20th place. Our final event of the day was the 4x400 relay with a team of Deanna Wood, Zoie Wood, Morgan Modert, and Madison Cooley who almost matched their season best time with a 4:25.28 to win their heat, and finish in 14th place overall.
