



COLUMBIA TOWNSHIP TIRE COLLECTION

Columbia Township's Transfer Station is collecting tires until August 20, 2023, at no cost to Columbia Township property owners (no tractor, ex-large or semi tires). The Township is required to obtain 500 tires by August 18, 2023, to receive grant noney to reduce the number of tires in the township.

There is no limit to the amount of tires you bring in on normal Transfer Station hours, but the Township is restricted to collecting 900 tires through August 18, 2023, during normal Transfer Stations hours. Once 900 tires are collected the transfer station cannot accept more until August 19th.

Happy summer everyone! If your house is like mine, there is plenty on the calendar for the family while school is out. As you and your loved ones enjoy new adventures, I encourage you to savor every single moment together, being very present and attentive.

In my journey of kindness over the last year, something has really stood out to me. I honestly am not sure if this is a CO-VID isolation throw back but people are really struggling to listen. Inoticed first as I participated in meetings that people are quick to interrupt, talk over the speaker and flat out ignore those who are presenting or speaking. We have lost the art of paying attention to one another. Overall I see so many people anxious to get the words out of their own mouths, they simply do not wait for another person to finish their thoughts. Phones. Phones are a huge piece of this. Recently I participated in an end of the year department meeting. The individual who was the main presenter picked up her phone to look at the screen each and every time it made a sound. It was constant, and even if the distraction was only for a few seconds, it took the speaker off task and away from the people right there in the room. It really gave all of us the feeling that we were not really as important as the messages coming through via text. I sometimes struggle with staying focused so I was really becoming agitated each and every time I heard the phone buzz, as I knew that the attention of the speaker would flip not to what we were discussing, but what message was being delivered.

Often people we are trying to engage with do not even look up from their phone to give someone speaking eye

contact. That is a horrible feeling of unimportance. Imagine trying to share something or ask a question and not feel that the listener cares. We have a lot of sad and lonely people who in reality are surrounded by people all day, but feel disconnected due to the value society places on technology over people. It is a miserable feeling to feel lonely in a space full of other people.

I encourage you to make listening a priority.

Put down the phone.

and ideas.

Turn off the television.

Listen to what a person is saying, lean in a little. Listen to actually hear what is being said, and acknowledge what vou heard

Pay attention to how the person talking is feeling. Let the person finish speaking before you add your thoughts

It's not nearly as important to offer advice or your own thoughts as it is to give the speaker the time to actually

listen to them, and care about what they are saving. There will be a lot of opportunities this summer to give good listening a try. I live with teenagers so I understand how troubling it can be not to interrupt or how tempting it can be to tune out. I'm never sorry when I actually shut down my speaking and turn up my listening. Some day you will need someone to actively listen to you. Be present. Focus on your friends and family. Make this summer the one



Van Buren County - The SWxSW Corner Cooperative Invasive Species Management Area (CISMA) in partnership with the Van Buren Conservation District and the Van Buren County Road Commission, will apply herbicide to the invasive species, Phragmites and invasive knotweed growing along county road Rights of Way. Treatment will begin August 2nd, 2023 and will continue until the first hard frost of the season. This will be a foliar spray of Habitat (imazapyr) that is dyed blue and applied using backpack sprayers. Invasive knotweed and Phragmites grow aggressively in natural areas, around buildings and homes, along bodies of water, and in Rights of Way. Do not touch or be near roadside plants with blue liquid. 

CLEAN, DRAIN, DRY It wouldn't be a Michigan summer without the water! And we each have a part to play

n protecting and preserving our waters. As we hit the water in our boats, paddle boards or waders, the Van Buren Conservation District (VDCD) and the SWxSW Corner CISMA both want to remind everyone to Clean, Drain, and Dry before heading home! Follow these steps to avoid fines, protect our fish and water from invasive species,

and keep our waterways enjoyable for everyone: • Clean: Remove all visible plant parts or dirt from boats. Double check pinch points on

railers or props for stragglers! Many aquatic plants can reproduce from just one leaf, so no matter what type of plant it is, best to remove any you may carry along. Waders and their soles should also be brushed off to prevent the spread of invasive • **Drain:** Pull all drain plugs and empty water from all live wells. Make sure to tip out

vater from kayaks/canoes. Bring ice to transport fish home. Fish diseases, such as Viral Hemorrhagic Septicemia, or VHS, can live in water, VHS can kill over 25 species of fish in Michigan, including popular sport fish such as muskie, yellow perch, and lake whitefish.

 Dry: Completely dry all your gear before heading back out, either in the sun orwith a
owel. Species like zebra mussels have larvae which can survive as long as they are wet! Th is important to remember for smaller craft, like paddle boards or kayaks, and any paddles • Dump: Always dump your bait in the trash, not over the side of the boat! Asian carp,

the nightmare of the Great Lakes, have been found in bait fish! Even night crawlers can cause big problems in our forests, where they can make it harder for our maple trees or wildflowers to germinate

Invasive species can be costly to our environment, our economy, and our health. In order to protect our waters, including your favorite swimming spot or fishing hole, everyone has to take part! Remember to Clean, Drain, Dry, and Dump to help stop the spread of invasive
