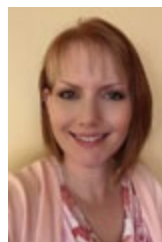
I also want to congratulate all the kindergarten through high school students for participating in this year's Covert/Thread of Hope summer programming. I am so proud of you.

ANTI HARASSMENT POLICY

PESTICIDE CONTROL ACT - PA 451

The Van Buren Intermediate School District has adopted an Integrated Pest Management program. Inherent with this are the District's efforts to reduce pesticide use as much as possible. While it may occasionally be necessary to apply a pesticide, these will only be used as a last resort. This program **does not** rely on routine pesticide applications to resolve problems. We use various techniques such as habitat alteration, sanitation, mechanical means, exclusion, etc. to prevent pest from becoming a problem.

You will receive advanced notice of the application of a pesticide, other than bait or gel formulations at your child's school. This advance notice of the application will be given 48 hours before the application. The law requires us to do this notification by using two methods. The first method required by the law is the posting at the primary entrances to your child's school. The entrances that will be posted are those entrances that have a sidewalk that leads directly to a parking lot. The second method we are going to use is the posting in a common area located by the main office of the school. Parents are also entitled to receive this notice by first-class United States mail postmarked at least three days before the application. If you would like to be notified by mail please contact David Johnson, Maintenance Supervisor at (269) 539-5233. Please give your name, mailing address and what school your child attends. In an emergency (for example, bees nest), pesticides may be applied without prior notice, but you will be provided notice following any such application. You may review our IPM program or pesticide application records for your child's school by contacting David Johnson at (269) 539-5233 or email djohnson@vbsid.org. This number or e-mail may also be used when school is not in regular session.

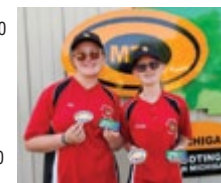
Bangor Vikings Trap Team

SHERIFF'S CORNER

VAN BUREN COUNTY SHERIFF DANIEL E. ABBOTT

- Total calls for service for our county after the end of July is at 41,642. That is a break down of police (15,590), traffic stops (11,448), animal control (942), ems (6,807), fire (1,090), and Misc cad (5,765).

- Our office handled 1,305 calls for service for the month of July.

- The Narcotic Unit continues to stay busy and proactive. They executed a search warrant just north of Gobles and recovered meth components as well as meth. Two subjects are being charged to the incident.

- We had a few vacant properties and seasonal residences broken into as well as items stolen outside the buildings. We ask community members, if they know a residence is seasonal or property is abandoned, to keep an eye on it as well. If you see anything suspicious, call immediately.

- The Uniform Response Division recovered 4 stolen quads and a stolen trailer out of another county. After the investigation, they were returned to the victim.

- The Uniform Response Division took a larceny of building materials. The materials were located in another township and returned to the victims. The incident remains under investigation.

- We unfortunately took some serious calls in the last several months in which minors were the victims. We were able to get resolutions quickly with the suspects being lodged. Due to the nature of the incidents, I won't be releasing details. I cannot stress enough how important it is to contact law enforcement if you think a minor is being abused or a victim in any way.




