### TRAFFIC FLOW: STUDENT DROP OFF AND PICK UP

Middle/High School Parking Lot (off of M-40). Traffic will enter from the north entrance and follow to the front of the school to drop off MS/HS students. ### **Using Airplanes to Fly On Cover Crops**

Farmers are doing their part to help keep Michigan's beautiful lakes and rivers clean. Planting cover crops is one method that farmers use to keep our water clean. A cover crop is a plant that is used to prevent erosion, improve soil health, enhance water quality, control weeds, control pests and diseases,

and increase biodiversity.

Cover crops are planted in the late-summer and early-fall after cash crops like corn and soybeans are harvested. The cover crops use leftover nutrients in the soil and hold them there so they do not run off into nearby water bodies. Those nutrients are then available for the cash crop to use the next growing season. Cover crops also have deep roots that add organic matter to the soil and break up hard ground which can make farming easier. Cover crops are a win-win for farmers and water quality.

One of the ways to get cover crops planted into fields is by flying them on. Airplanes are hired to spread the cover crop seeds over fields. By flying on, farmers are able to get the cover crop planted before harvest and capture more time to grow. On average, we lose an hour and a half of sunlight and 15 degrees between September and October. By planting cover crops in early September, the cover crops will have more time to grow and get their roots established. There are other cover crop planting methods such as drilling the

seed in, however, this requires the farmer to wait until after harvest. This means the cover crop will lose those crucial growing days.

Lastly, thanks to ALL our past donors and volunteers that have helped make a difference in our communities' children's lives.








