

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF SOUTH HAVEN CHARTER TOWNSHIP

Section 1. Purpose. This section provides the purpose of the Ordinance. Section 2. Amendment of Article IV. This section amends Sections 4.03 and 4.04 of the Township's Zoning Ordinance regarding permitted special uses and dimensional standards in the RD Zoning District

Section 3. Amendment of Article V. This section amends Sections 5.03 and 5.04 of the Township's Zoning Ordinance regarding permitted special uses and dimensional standards in the AR Zoning District.

Section 4. Amendment of Article VI. This section amends Section 6.04 of the Township's Zoning Ordinance regarding dimensional standards in the MDR Zoning District. Section 5. Amendment of Article VII. This section amends Sections 7.03 and 7.04 of the Township's Zoning Ordinance regarding permitted special uses and dimensional standards in the LDR Zoning District.

Section 6. Amendment of Article VIII. This section amends Section 8.04 of the Township's Zoning Ordinance regarding dimensional standards in the HDR Zoning District. Section 7. Amendment of Article 9A. This section amends Article 9A of the Township's Zoning Ordinance regarding standards in the RCO Zoning District.

Section 8. Amendment of Article 10. This section amends Article 10 of the Township's Zoning Ordinance regarding standards in the NSC Zoning District.

Section 9 Amendment of Article 11 This section amends Article 11 of the Townshin's Zoning Ordinance regarding standards in the CSC Zoning District.

Section 10 Amendment of Article XII This section amends Section 12 07 of the Town ship's Zoning Ordinance regarding dimensional standards in the HSC Zoning District. Section 11. Amendment of Article XIII. This section amends Section 13.05 of the Township's Zoning Ordinance regarding dimensional standards in the HC Zoning Dis-

Section 12. Amendment of Article 14. This section amends Article 14 of the Township's Zoning Ordinance standards in the I Zoning District.

Section 13. Amendment of Article 14B. This section amends Article 14B of the Township's Zoning Ordinance regarding standards in the Shoreline Protection Overlay Zoning

Section 14. Amendment of Article XVIII. This section amends Sections 18.20, 18.27, 18.28 and 18.31 of the Township's Zoning Ordinance regarding private pools, jacuzzis and hot tubs, recreational vehicles, temporary-use events and temporary dwellings and use of mobile homes as temporary dwellings

Section 15. Validity and Severability. This section provides that any section or subsection not expressly amended by this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Should any portion of this Ordinance be found invalid for any reason, such holding shall not be construed as affecting the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 16. Repealer Clause. This section provides that any ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed only to the extent necessary to give this Ordinance full force and effect.

Section 17. Effective Date. This section provides that this Ordinance shall take effect seven days after publication as provided by law.




