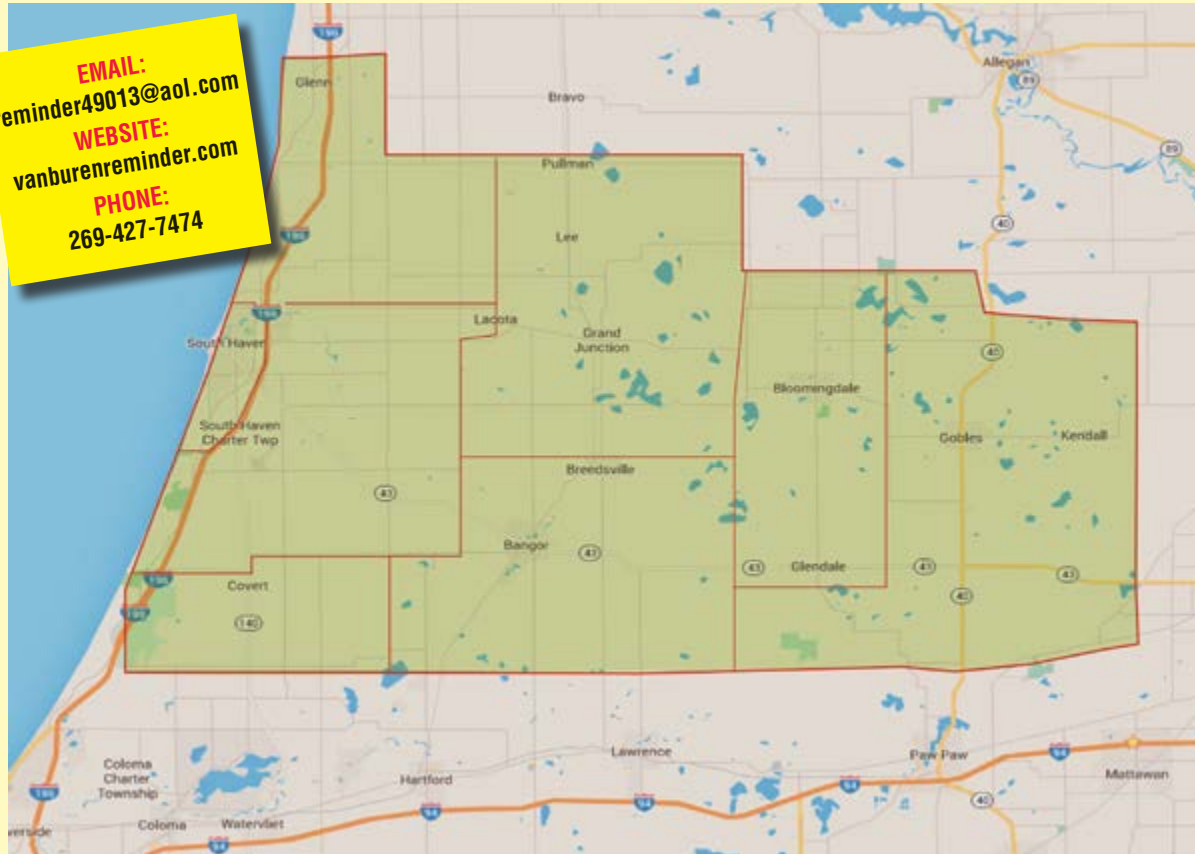

SHERIFF'S CORNER

VAN BUREN COUNTY SHERIFF DANIEL E. ABBOTT

We will be doing our yearly Christmas Families on the 9th this year. Our Christmas Families are being blessed different this year. Every year, we get families in need, shop for them, then deliver everything to them. This year, we are having all the families meet with several of us from the office to shop with us. "Shopping with the Sheriff" is a different twist this year having them participate in the whole event and being able to pick out something they may need that we weren't aware of. The money used is never taxpayer dollars and Meijers every year donates to the cause as well. Being able to give back to the community this way is heartwarming for all of us here. We take an oath to serve and protect, and part of that is giving back to our community in our eyes such as this. I personally cannot express my thanks enough for everyone behind the scenes to make this happen. Our School Resource Deputies as well as a Detective chose the families this year.

Uniform Response took a UTV crash in a field in Keeler Township involving two subjects. The UTV overturned, landing on one of the subjects. The 53-year-old Berrien County Resident lost his life from the crash. The other occupant refused treatment at the scene. Deputies were assisted by other agencies on this helping get the UTV off the victim, CPR, and transport out of the field.

Uniform Response took a Felonious Assault in Antwerp Township in which a juvenile assaulted a parent and brother with a baseball bat. The juvenile also hit and kicked them. The Juvenile Facility was full, so Deputies were unable to lodge the suspect in this. A report was taken, and the incident will be handled moving forward through the court system. No serious injuries were reported from the incident.

Dispatch and Uniform Response have been seeing an uptick in subjects going into neighborhoods looking for unlocked vehicles to go through. As always, keep your possessions out of sight when possible and keep your vehicles locked.

We recently purchased a drone for the Uniform Response Sergeants Patrol Unit. With that, they will all be trained to operate it. Having it in the unit will give us quicker drone deployments when needed and applicable.

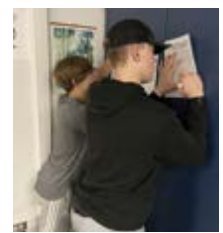

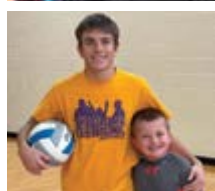

Microfarming is small-scale, sustainably-minded farming, generally conducted by hand. Microfarms serve different purposes. Our focus would be, first, to provide a unique learning experience for our students that addresses specific curricular needs within our Science, Social Studies, and Marketing Departments. Second, to foster greater collaboration between the Gobles Community and Gobles Public Schools.

The possibilities of this endeavor are vast. For example, we may start with vegetables and small livestock. The kids could market what they sell including any meat birds and eggs. The processing of any animals could become a dissection assignment. However, this will not happen without community support.

Students here are part of the Agriscience and Woodshop class. They are building a small barn that will serve as the base of operations for the microfarm. The barn is expected to be done by the end of the semester.

English Department

The Gift that Keeps on Giving

It's that time of the year again when parents start thinking about gifts for their teens. When you're looking for a great gift idea this holiday season that is affordable and fits into a stocking, don't forget about the power of a good book to work its magic on a young mind. Okay, so it might not come as a surprise to learn that there are few parts of the job for English teachers as gratifying than seeing what happens when a student finds a book they can really get lost in while reading. There is no experience quite like it.

Even the most reluctant or resistant readers can become enthusiastic about a book that they connect with, be it an interest or a story that speaks to something important to their own lives or lives they had not imagined before. Books have been called mirrors, because a student can read stories that they identify with, and they can think for themselves about how characters figure out the challenges they face, and how the reader would face it if he was in a similar situation. But books can be windows, too, giving students a chance to look out at the wider world and learn new things and experience delight or compassion or the thrill of discovery.

One of the reasons English teachers read aloud to students is to model different kinds of stories in different genres, such as adventure or fantasy or books about cars, or candy bars, or movie stars. But the most important thing, whether the story is about teenagers or aliens or fighting fire-breathing dragons, is that teens see something about themselves in the book they are reading or it gives them an experience of something they've never known.

The secret to finding a book your teen will love starts with believing there are books out there your teen will enjoy. Your student's English teachers would love to talk to you about the kinds of books students connect to, and your local librarians are experts at doing it as well (and you can even borrow those books for free.) So this holiday season, give your student a ticket to as far away as their imagination can take them, a break from screens for a few quiet evenings, and a chance to stretch their minds. When a teen reader connects with a book, that gift keeps on giving to a mind that has been opened.
