
ine reference someone stealing gas. These incidents appear to be related to each other. No suspect/suspects have been developed vet.

Detectives went out over the weekend into Cass County to recover stolen property from a complaint our office took in Hartford Township about a week ago. Our Detectives worked in conjunction with Cass County Sheriff's Office on the recovery with a search warrant for the residence as well. Several stolen items were recovered as well as other items that are believed to be stolen. Multiple suspects will be charged with numerous felonies for the incident. Two were lodged upon recovering the items and warrants are being sought for the other two.

Multiple Divisions from our office assisted the Decatur School System and Decatur PD with a bomb threat. The school was evacuated and staged at the VFW until students could be picked up or taken home from there. It was found through the investigation that the threat came out of New York. Kent County had multiple threats in their school systems Monday and the FBI is helping them investigate theirs.

Uniform Response went to a suspicious situation in Keeler Township. When the Deputy arrived, a male subject was confrontational and aggressive towards him. The Deputy tazed the subject and ultimately arrested him. The Deputy was not hurt during the incident and the subject tazed was charged with the offense and lodged at our facility.
