



Iniform Response is actively looking for the individual from Keeler Township to arrest him on the warrant

Uniform Response went to a residence in Geneva Township in the late hours after dark for a suspicious situation. The homeowner heard something outside and when investi-gating it, saw a figure out by the road. The subject/subjects in question were not located. Nothing was taken during the incident. Uniform Response took a stolen 2009 Harley Davidson Sportster Motorcycle Black and

Orange in color from Arlington Township. Unknown suspects entered through a fenced in area at a storage facility and broke into it where the motorcycle was being stored. Anyone Uniform Response arrested a 20-year-old Decatur Resident for Stalking. It was a war-

rant issued on a previous investigation, and when the Deputies went to arrest him, he fought with them. The suspect was put into custody and charged with that incident as well as the Stalking Warrant

A Felony Warrant was issued on a Hartford Man for Malicious Destruction of a Build-ing-\$1,000 or more but less than \$20,000 which is a 5-year felony. The subject caused damage to our jail while being held here. Just so the public knows, we submit charges on individuals who damage our property such as this. Taxpayers should not and will not be covering damages for actions like this and the individual will be paying to get the damage fixed as well as being charged for the crime. This happens occasionally and they are held accountable

Uniform Response assisted Kalamazoo County Sheriff's Office and a victim from Ka-Iamazoo County with recovering stolen property in Waverly Township. The victim found the test of the stolen property on Facebook. Uniform Response got all the needed information on the complaint then went to the residence in question to investigate it further and confirm it was the victims' items. The homeowner initially was not cooperating with Deputies but eventually did just prior to the search warrant being signed. The items were indeed the victims from Kalamazoo County. The items were turned back over to the victims, and a report will be sent to the Prosecutor for review on charges along with Kalamazoo's report. Uniform Response handled a couple of Break-in's in Antwern Township Deputies were able to get a photo off a surveillance system of a suspect vehicle. Deputies were able to enhance the photo and get the license plate. Deputies followed up on the vehicle in question and located it at a residence in Plainwell. Inside the vehicle was several of the stolen items from the Break-in's. There are two suspects involved with these incidents The male suspect is a Lawton Resident and is currently on Parole out of our county for prior Break-in's and Larcenies. A report will be forwarded to the Prosecutor for charges against those involved and the male in question is now lodged at our facility. This is an ongoing investigation to see if the suspects were involved in other Break-in's in South west Michigan.


