SHERIFF'S CORNER

VAN BUREN COUNTY SHERIFF DANIEL E. ABBOTT

Dispatcher Brianna Doberstein was given a Certificate of Commendation at the 911 Advisory Board Meeting. Brianna handled a call in which a subject was getting ready to commit suicide. Brianna remained calm and collected and was able to handle the call with a positive outcome. The caller did get the help needed to the scene and is alive today due to her actions.

Dispatcher Emily Stroh received her first "Stork Certificate" as well as a Certificate of Commendation at the 911 Advisory Board Meeting. Emily received a 911 call from a male subject advising that he was on M43hwy heading to Bronson because his girlfriend was in labor having a baby. Emily was able to walk the father through the delivery process on the side of the road. The healthy baby girl was delivered in the front seat of their vehicle. Emily walked the father through care for the newborn and mother until EMS arrived on scene.

Our Office assisted Lawton PD on a bomb threat called into the school. Detectives where able to determine the call was made through a third-party digital application known as Textnow. Several search warrants were executed on various IP and internet carrier services. The suspect was identified as a 7th grader from Cleveland, Ohio. The suspect was mad at a kid that attends Lawton Schools due to an argument from an online video game site, so he called in a bomb threat to get back at the student. Being a juvenile, the case is being transferred to West Lake PD as it's their jurisdiction in Ohio. The Ohio Judicial System will determine the outcome on the case.

Uniform Response policed a car vs tree accident in Pine Grove Township. The 83-year-old driver straightened out a curve without braking on CR388 and hit a tree. It was found that the driver appeared to be having a medical condition that caused the crash. She was transported to Bronson and was admitted due to her injuries. Currently, it does not appear that her injuries are life threatening.

Uniform Response handled a single vehicle crash in Lawrence Township which was called in by a resident in the area. The driver was unresponsive and had to be extricated by Lawrence Fire Department. It was found that the 48-year-old Berrien Springs Resident was the only occupant. The vehicle hit several trees, causing severe damage to the vehicle and injuries to the driver. The driver was transported to Kalamazoo Bronson and remained unresponsive. The accident remains open and further follow up will be done on it for the investigation.

Uniform Response handled an Assault Complaint in Columbia Township. The investigation showed that a subject was cut in the neck during an altercation with a box cutter knife. The suspect was arrested and charged with Assault With a Dangerous Weapon. The victim went to the hospital and was treated for their injuries.

Criminal Investigation Detectives assisted Uniform Response with executing a search warrant for a residence in the Village of Paw Paw. Deputies took several mail theft complaints around the Paw Paw/Mattawan/Lawton Area and developed a suspect; hence the search warrant being executed. Upon the execution of the search warrant, more stolen mail was discovered in the residence. A confession was obtained as well as more crimes that were committed which the suspect admitted to. Charges are pending currently on the cases.

Uniform Response handled a bus vs car accident in Waverly Township. The driver of the at fault vehicle fell asleep and reentered a bus as it just picked up some kids and was pulling away from the stop getting up to speed. There were 13 kids on the bus and no injuries were reported with them. The driver of the vehicle went by EMS to the hospital for injuries.

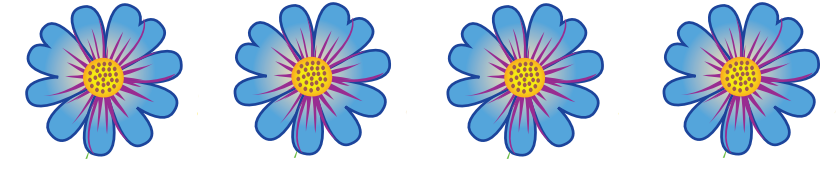

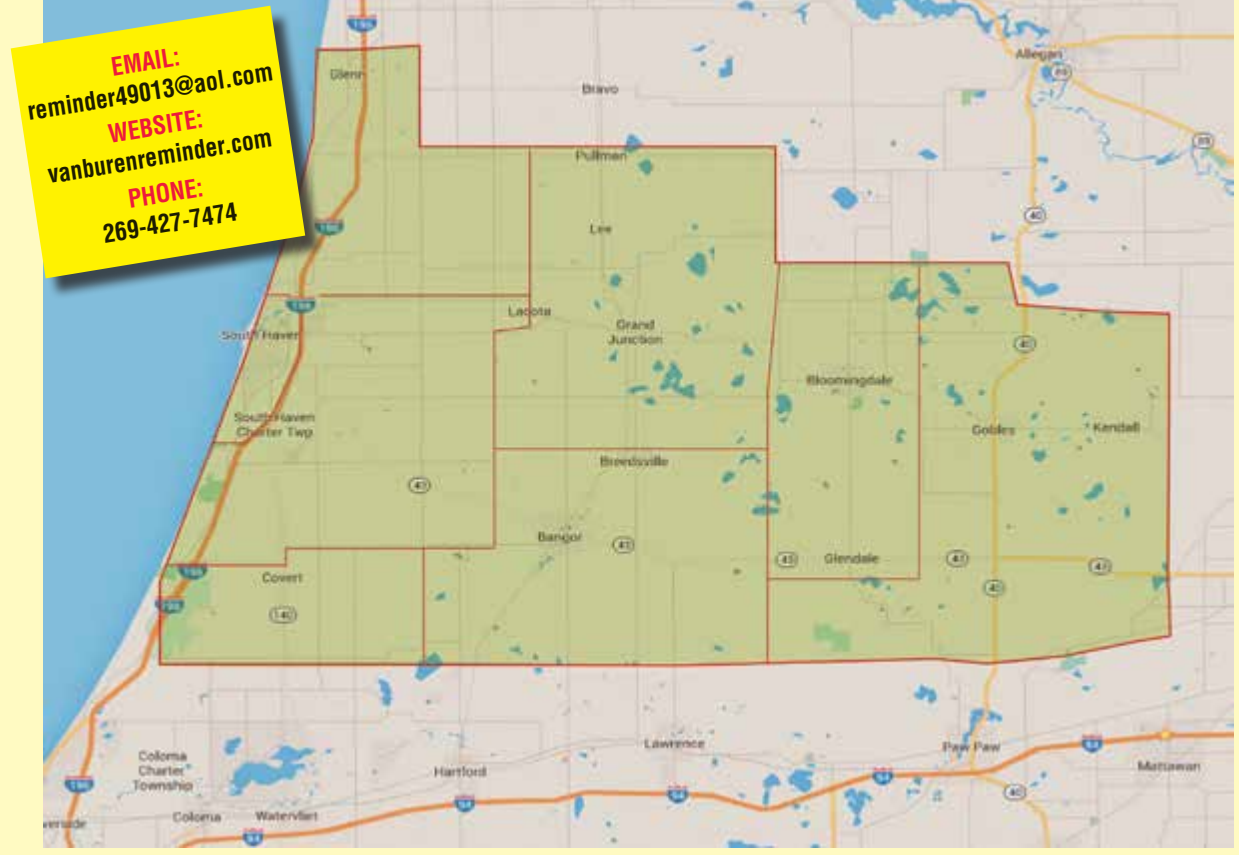
