ARLINGTON TOWNSHIP

Arlington Township officials failed to respond to multiple complaints against Board member, Georgette Peterson, alleging that state law prohibits her from serving as both Clerk on the Board of Trustees and Marijuana Coordinator. The complaint argues that Peterson cannot hold the two positions simultaneously due to it being in violation of the Michigan Incompatible Public Offices Act of 1978.

The act defines "incompatible offices" as public offices held by a public official which, when the official is performing the duties of any of the public offices held by the official, results in any of the following with respect to those offices held:

During the January 18, 2023 Board of Trustees neeting, Peterson supported a motion that she be appointed as interim marijuana coordinator. During the Board discussion, Peterson was accused of being too negative on marijuana growers. The motion died from lack of support.

At the subsequent meeting on February 15, 2023 the motion to appoint Peterson as Interim Marijuana Coordinator was again brought before the Board and carried 4-1. Shockingly, at this same meeting, a motion was also passed to pay Peterson \$18.00 an hour, for 20 nours a week, for marijuana administration work.

Public officials are prohibited from using their position of authority in an act resulting in personal profit or gain. Peterson gained additional earnings of \$1,440 a month as Marijuana Coordinator, and a salary increase with her promotion from Trustee to Clerk. Undue self-enrichment has enabled Peterson to nearly double her earnings, which are currently estimated to be approximately \$37,000 yearly.

Following the resignation of the former Marijuana Coordinator on . 2022, the vacancy was advertised. Fifteen applications were received for the position, but never presented for Board consideration Peterson has held the position for 18 months and there have been no subsequent efforts to continue advertising for and recruiting a Marijuana Coordinator.

Transparency regarding self-interest, conflicts, and voting is central to the Open Meetings Act and the Freedom of Information Act, which permit public scrutiny of Board members' official actions. A Board member who ignores rules and abuses his or her pow er, exposes the Township to liability and deprives citizens of their rights and opportunities.

During Phillippe's tenure, Arlington had the largest number of grower licenses per capita in the state, 1 license per 20 residents. She believed charging the maximum fee of \$5,000per license as well as receiving a share of the state excise tax would result in unprecedented wealth for the community. More licenses DID NOT equal more available cash, because the Medical Marihuana Facilities Licensing Act, Act 281 of 2016 included restrictions on the

opt in. On November 6, 2018, 351 Arlington Township residents voted NO for Proposa 18-1, regarding adult use of marijuana, while 340 voted YES.

During Phillippe's tenure, marijuana policies invited a flood of investors and specula-ors, permitted growing operations in restricted wetlands, and ignored citizens' concerns Marijuana ordinances were cut and pasted together, and unrealistic promises were made As a result, seven grow operations were placed in wetlands; license fees were placed in the general fund, not designated marijuana accounts; adjacent land use considerations for grow placement were ignored; no retail or micro-businesses were established; and residents are dealing with the noxious odor of cultivation. Former Planning Commissio member David Holmes, now running for Supervisor, proudly states that he was par of this process. At the August 15, 2018, Board Meeting, Phillippe, Pugsley, Pitts, DeLeo and Melvin voted to pay the Supervisor (Phillippe), Zoning Administrator, and Planning Commission Chairman an additional \$100 per application to compensate them for work done on medical marijuana applications and issues.

In the November 2020 election, Koshar defeated Phillippe, garnering 70% of the vote. The current Board inherited a mess and has worked diligently to clean it up. New marijuana ordinances were drafted and approved. Lawsuits inherited from mismanage ment and unrealistic promises were resolved and settled favorably. The Marijuana Coor dinator has been working with the local growers and Cannabis Regulatory Agency, maximizing efficiency and expertise. We have addressed long neglected issues such as flooding at South Scott Lake. We continue working to update the 2012 DRAFT ZONING ORDI-NANCES that were NEGLECTED during the 8 years Phillippe was supervisor. We are currently revising the Township Master Plan. We continue to encourage community inpuinto decision making. The Planning Commission is encouraging resident participation b drafting resolutions to establish: a Resident Road Commission, Resident Commission for Cultural and Historical Preservation, and Resident Commission for Business Develop ment. The current Treasurer, Jill Sanborn, has traced all the marijuana license fees and eparated them into specific accounts, because their use is restricted

Georgette Peterson (Supervisor), LuAnn Sell (Clerk), Jill Sanborn (Treasurer), Ron Klein (Trustee), and Ted Swanson (Trustee) are running to preserve our rural community through wel thought out planning that is based on facts and resident input.
