Cinnamon Vine & Butterbur: New Plants, Same Story

Be on the lookout for cinnamon vine and butterbur! These two invasive plants are relatively new to Southwest Michigan and have the potential to spread out of control if left unchecked. An invasive species is an animal or plant that is not native and whose introduction causes harm to our economy, environment and human health. While these plants are still new to our area, let's keep an eye out for them so we can prevent them from becoming a bigger problem. It's much easier to deal with a small young patch than a well-established mature patch

Cinnamon Vine
Cinnamon vine (*Dioscorea polystachya*), formerly called Chinese yam, is a vine which can spread rapidly to choke out native plants, creating a blanket over trees and shrubs. Cinnamon vine can be identified by its heart shaped leaves, which have indents on the sides. It also has tubers resembling tiny potatoes along its vines.

Butterbur
Butterbur (*Petasites hybridus*) is a perennial plant with round leaves that can be up to two feet across. In early spring it has a pink or purple flower before the leaves grow. It spreads easily in moist areas by rhizomes (roots). Butterbur has large leaves that crowd out other plants, preventing them from growing. It commonly spreads after being planted in gardens or landscaping, completely filling those gardens and escaping into natural areas.

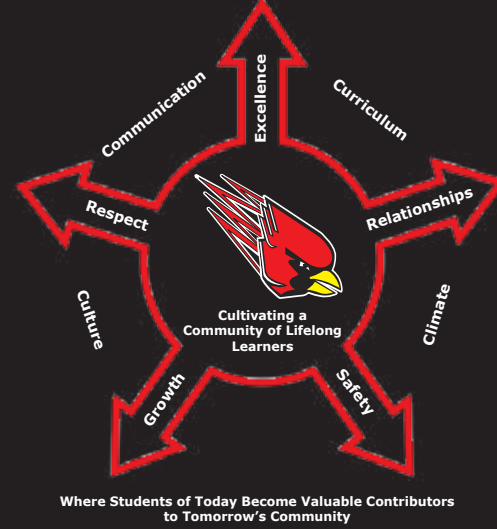

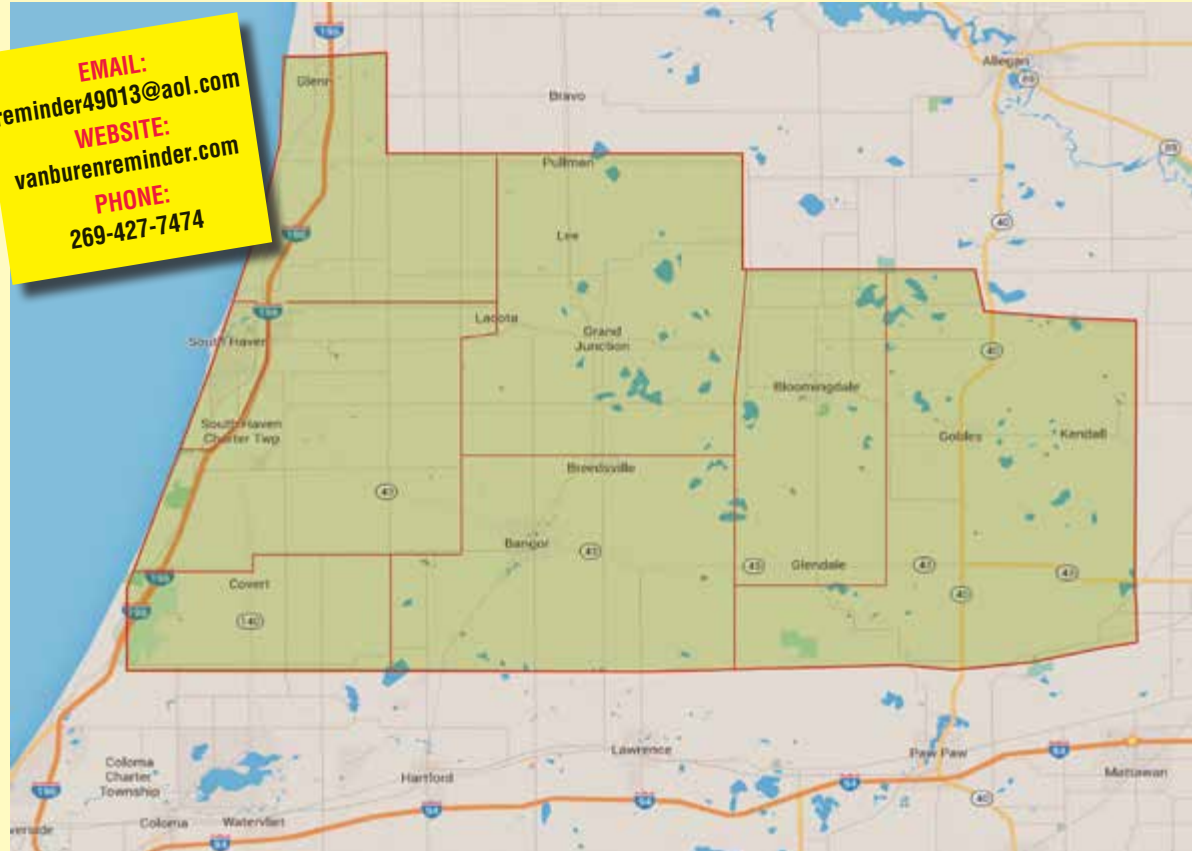
