



## Tigers take down Eau Claire 54-0, Move to 6-0

The Tigers came into the week ranked #4 in the state. The Tigers were able to capitalize on good field possession, and a great offensive line play as they rolled to a big win. Gobles rushed for 278 yards and held Eau Claire to 160 yards of total offense. Overall, the offense executed well and the defense was aggressive at the point of attack.

The offense took advantage of good field possession for most of the night and averaged 8.6 yards per play, which racked up the points early. Preston Misak led the Tigers with 83 yards rushing on 8 attempts, 3 rushing TDs, and 1 TD in the air. Finn Carlin, Mason Mansfield, and Caleb O'Connor all chipped in with a touchdown. Regardless of who was running the ball, the offensive line collectively played well enough to pave the way.

The Tiger's defense saw a nice rotation of players chip into the shutout win. A total of 20 players recorded at least one tackle throughout the game. The defense was again led by the stellar play of Nathan Ray, who tallied 12 tackles (3 TFL), 1 QB pressure, and a .5 sack. AJ Salinas added 7 tackles and a fumble recovery, while Aiden Beam finished with 6 tackles, and Mansfield had 5 tackles, 1 QB pressure, and a .5 sack. Misak added a big interception later in the game to stop the Beavers from a potential score and secured the shutout for Gobles.

Gobles now plays at Martin on Friday, October 11th. The stakes are high with a divisional championship on the line and a chance to remain undefeated.


Creating a culture of deliberate excellence






