Holiday Clean Up
 We at the Van Buren Conservation District hope you, your family, and friends all had safe and happy holidays. Now that the holiday season is wrapping up, here are some environmentally friendly ways to clean up.

Christmas Trees
 If you opted for a living Christmas tree, there are many options to choose from to mindfully dispose or reuse your festive tree. Living trees are biodegradable! This means, if you have enough acreage and local ordinances allow, you can let your tree decompose outside. This method provides habitat for many insects, birds, and other animals with a minimal amount of effort. Likewise, living trees can be mulched (with the proper equipment) and used for a variety of things like landscaping. Your former Christmas tree can also be added to your compost. Do not burn your Christmas tree in your fireplace or wood stove. The sap from fresh trees can sometimes create a fire hazard in your chimney or vent piping. It is not worth the risk! While promptly burning your tree midwinter in an outside bonfire could be okay, if local laws and practical safety allow, indoor burning is not a good idea because of this safety concern.

Unwanted Gifts
 We have all received gifts that we did not want or would never use. Before throwing these gifts away or putting them in storage to never be seen again, consider donating them to your local thrift store. "One man's trash is another person's treasure" is the advice here. While you have no desire or use for the item, someone somewhere would be happy to have such an item and the extra storage space will make you happier.

Electronics
 Many of us will receive new electronics as gifts or even just noticing that some of our electronics do not work any more. Even your old Christmas lights that are burnt out can be recycled! When replacing old electronics with new electronics, be sure to recycle them. Van Buren County residents and landowners can recycle their electronics for free at Lakeview Community Thrift Store (1000 E. Michigan Ave., Paw Paw, MI 49079).

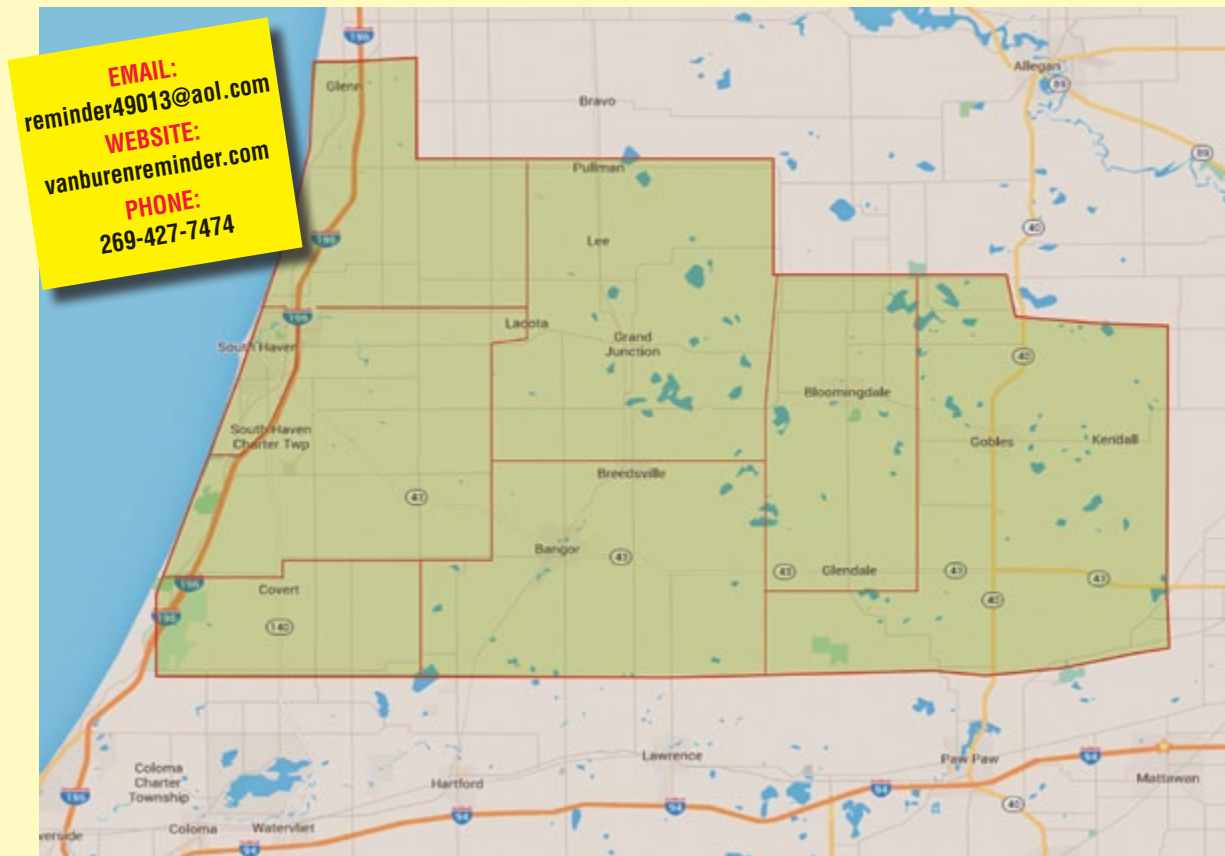
