



If you opted for a living Christmas tree, there are many options to choose from to mindfully lispose or reuse your festive tree.

iving trees are biodegradable! This means, if you have enough acreage and local ordinances llow, you can let your tree decompose outside. This method provides habitat for many insects, pirds, and other animals with a minimal amount of effort. Likewise, living trees can be mulched with the proper equipment) and used for a variety of things like landscaping. Your former Chris

Oo not burn your Christmas tree in your fireplace or wood stove. The sap from fresh trees can sometimes create a fire hazard in your chimney or vent piping. It is not worth the risk! While promptly burning your tree midwinter in an outside bonfire could be okay, if local laws and pract cal safety allow, indoor burning is not a good idea because of this safety concern

We have all received gifts that we did not want or would never use. Before throwing these gifts away or putting them in storage to never be seen again, consider donating them to your local thrift store. "One man's trash is another person's treasure" is the advice here. 


