

NOTICE OF ADOPTION AND SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE NO. 152 ORDINANCE AMENDING MARIHUANA ESTABLISHMENTS ORDINANCE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that at its meeting on January 11, 2023, the Township Board adopted Ordinance No. 152 entitled "Ordinance Amending Marihuana Establishments Ordinance." The following is a summary the regulatory effect of the Ordinance. A true copy of the Ordinance is available for inspection or purchase at the Township Hall, 09761 Blue Star Memorial Highway, South Haven, Michigan

ORDINANCE NO. 152

ORDINANCE AMENDING MARIHUANA ESTABLISHMENTS ORDINANCE

Section 1 changes the effective date of the Township's Marihuana Establishments Ordinance from February 1, 2023, to April 1, 2023.

Section 2 modifies the timing as to when the Township Board may impose a "cap" (adopt a limit on the maximum number of permissible marihuana establishments) and amends the language as to the effect of adopting that cap.

Section 3 modifies the timing as to when the Township Board may adopt police power and zoning regulations related to marihuana establishments and amends the language as to the permissible scope of those regulations.

Section 4 amends the timeline for the Township Board to adopt police power and zoning regulations related to marihuana establishments from April 1, 2023, to August 1, 2023.

Section 5 provides that if any portion of the Ordinance is found invalid for any reason, such holding shall not be construed as affecting the validity of the remaining portions of the Ordinance.

Section 6 provides that any ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the Ordinance are repealed to the extent necessary to give the Ordinance full force and

Section 7 provides that the Ordinance is effective immediately after publication.






